

USE OF FIRE

In the case of an emergency, the main switchboards are in:-
Great Oaks - the inside store room
Little Acorns - the back corridor

Outside

Fires to be built only on slabs provided
Fires to be built at least **15 metres** from buildings and sheds
Fires not to be built anywhere near lawnmower

Controlled fires only to be built, not large bonfires
Fires not to be left unattended

At least one bucket of water should be filled and placed within easy reach
- more in dry summers.
Fire beaters should be placed within easy reach of the fire in dry weather
Fire buckets (and fire beaters) are stored on the veranda of Little Acorns

Fireworks

Fireworks should be lit on the opposite side of the field from Great Oaks
Fireworks should not be lit in the woodland
The firework safety code should be followed

Candles and nightlights

It is recognised that, from time to time candles or nightlights might be used indoors for effect.

In Great Oaks - Candles and nightlights may be used in the central room ONLY. They must be on tables, (or on non-flammable trays on the floor) well away from blinds, furnishings and other potentially flammable items. Young people must be carefully supervised, and must never be left unsupervised, in the room while naked flames are alight.

In Little Acorns - candles, nightlights and other naked flames must not be used.
